Bed bug treatment preparation

- 1) Wash beddings in hot water.
- 2) Provide a base bag containing personal effects washed that will be used during the duration of treatment.
- 3) Pick up the items lagging near the infested site (ex: toys, books).
- 4) Clean the collected objects and put them in a sealed bag.
- 5) Vacuum and throw the vacuum bag in a hermetically closed plastic bag and put in a trash outside of the building.
- 6) Empty the drawers and offices and wash clothes.
- 7) Empty the closets (guard dresses) and wash clothes.
- 8) Eliminate congestion and hiding places
- 9) Wash the drapes and curtains.
- 10) Put all washed clothes, bedding, draperies in hermetically closed plastic bags until the disappearance of infection confirmed by the exterminator.
- 11) Make sure that everything that comes out to the outside of the housing is free of bed bugs to prevent propagation.
- 12) Clear the bottom of the walls of at least 24 inches.
- 13) Unplug all your electrical appliances.

Note

Washing with hot water and use the dryer at high temperature for a minimum of 30 minutes. Do not fill the dryer more than half.

During treatment

All residents and their pets (including birds) must leave the premises for 4 to 6 hours.

After treatment

- 1) Ventilate the premises.
- 2) **VERY IMPORTANT** Do not wash the floors before 3 weeks.
- 3) It is highly recommended to cover the mattress with anti-Bed bug covers.
- 4) Provide 2nd treatment between 14 and 21 days, depending on the pesticide used.
